Should you require support with uniform, please let our staff know. We will do all we can to help.

Uniform at Cockshut Hill School

Please be aware that just because an item is labelled as 'schoolwear' in a shop - doesn't mean it meets our uniform policy. If in doubt, please check.

The School expects all learners, with the support of their parents and carers to comply with uniform requirements.

BLAZER	Black with school badge embroidered or sewn on.
SHIRT	Plain white preferably with long sleeves. Shirt collar button must be done up at all times.
TIE	Yr7, 8 & 9: House coloured striped, tied neatly with at least five coloured stripes displayed. Yr10 & 11: Black with school logo on, tied neatly at full length with school logo displayed just underneath the knot. <i>(KS4 tie supplied by school at the start of Year 10).</i>
TROUSERS	Black school trousers of a professional style and of a suitable material (not denim, lycra, corduroy, jeans or chinos). Trousers must be of an appropriate length, sitting on or below the ankle. They must not be 'drainpipe' very flared or 'turned up'. Learners who wear trousers must not have their lower leg or ankle exposed.
SKIRTS	Pleated black skirt that must sit at knee length. Skirts must be of an appropriate material, (eg; no lycra). If tights are worn they must be plain black or natural. If socks are worn they must be plain black ankle socks, not long socks pushed down.
FORMAL SHOES	Plain black polishable, professional shoe. No trainers/sport brands or polishable trainers. To be worn with plain black ankle socks. Please see additional shoe guidance.
BAG	These should be brought to school daily. They must be of an A4 size to carry a planner and exercise books, pencil cases and any other equipment necessary for lessons. Small handbag/pouches styles are prohibited.
JUMPER	Berry red of a plain V-neck style <i>(optional purchase).</i>
OUTDOOR WEAR <small>(when needed in addition to the blazer)</small>	Plain outdoor coat with a full length zip. Fur/teddy jackets, denim, leather look, hoodies, tracksuit tops, body warmers/gilets, sweatshirts or other leisure type garments are not allowed.
RELIGIOUS CLOTHING	Religious headwear such as hijabs, headscarves and turbans should be plain and black in colour. Requests to wear items that cannot be removed for religious reasons are considered individually.
HAIR BANDS	Black and plain design <i>(no more than 1cm wide).</i>

Uniform & Standards at Cockshut Hill

JEWELLERY	<p>One small stud type earring in each earlobe only.</p> <p>Nose rings/studs and tongue piercings are not allowed - even if they are covered by tape. Clear spacers are not allowed. Rings, bracelets, hooped earrings and other visible loose fitting items are not allowed.</p> <p>No other visible body piercing studs (<i>not even if covered by tape</i>).</p>
HATS/ SCARFS/ GLOVES	<p>No caps to be worn at any time. No hats, hoods, scarves or gloves should be worn inside the school buildings.</p>
BANNED ITEMS	<p>Hoodies, sweatshirts, tracksuit tops, sunglasses, knee length socks, caps, pinafores, necklaces, durags, over the shoulder pouches, boots, false eyelashes and false nails.</p>
MAKE UP	<p>Any make up should be of natural tones and subtle. Excessive make up is not allowed. No false eyelashes - learners will be asked to remove false eyelashes and these will be stored until parent/carer collection.</p>
NAILS	<p>False nails and coloured varnish are not permitted. Learners will be asked to remove false nails and nail varnish.</p>
HAIRSTYLES	<p>Learners must not wear extreme haircuts to school. Undercuts, shaved hair, tramlines or inappropriate hair colours are not permitted. Hair should be natural tone in colour. Final decisions about suitability will be made by the school.</p>
EQUIPMENT	<p>All learners are expected to bring the following equipment in a pencil case to each lesson:</p> <p>*Black Pen *Pencil *Ruler *Eraser *Highlighters *Green pen Reading book *School planner **Scientific calculator in an A4 size bag</p> <p><i>*Provided to all learners at the start of the academic year</i> <i>**Provided to all learners at the start of Year 7</i></p>
MOBILE PHONES ELECTRONIC DEVICES	<p>Mobile phones, electronic and connectable devices, <u>including smart watches and wearable AI</u>, should not be visible in school. Whilst we understand that learners may choose to bring such devices to school, they must not be used or seen on site at any time.</p> <p>Items that are confiscated will be secured in Student Services to be collected by parent/carers only at the end of the school day. Therefore, please talk to you child about the consequences if they have an item confiscated. Student Services closes at 3:30pm each day. Any items not collected by the end of the day will be stored securely.</p>
DRINKS	<p>All drinks brought into school must be plain/unflavoured/uncoloured water only. Water stations are available in the restaurant for learners to refill their water bottles at break and lunch. Flavoured water/squash/energy drinks/fizzy drinks are not allowed.</p>

NOT PERMITTED SHOES



Not permitted: • Air bubbles • Colourful tabs/labels/branding • Material/fabric/mesh/suede upper
• Coloured trim/soles/outlines of branding • Boots • High heels • Running trainers
